CLASS OF 2013 (SENIORS)

The class of 2013 in Colorado is very deep with dozens of talented prospects who are at least very strong Division II prospects or higher. Most of those prospects participated in the camp and performed very well.

The camp was led by the five players who were named the **Most Outstanding Players**. These players were **Daniel Meyer** (6'8" P Billings Central Catholic, MT HS 2013), **Dezmond James** (6'4" SG Ponderosa HS 2013), **Alex Terpstra** (6'4" SG Denver Christian HS 2013), **Spencer Svejcar** (6'3" CG Ralston Valley HS 2013) and **Zach Rusk** (6'3" SG ThunderRidge HS 2013). **Meyer** is a great looking prospect with tons of upside. He is very active around the rim and has a nice frame already. Some added skill development will make him a coveted post prospect due to his strong academics as well. **James** is one of the premiere players in Colorado. He has a long, thick frame and uses those assets to be a tremendous defender and score well at all three levels. Coming off a very strong spring, **James** is poised for a big July. **Terpstra** is a long wing who is a lights out shooter. He has one of the purest strokes in the region and a quick release. Coming off a high school season where he won a state title and was named First Team All-State, **Terpstra** should have a strong summer. **Svejcar** was perhaps the most impressive player at the camp. He can play either guard spot and has a strong build that he uses to score well at the rim. He is also a good shooter from mid range and beyond the stripe and is a very tough defender. Finally, **Rusk** was outstanding in the camp as well. He has been one of the most highly regarded players in his class since he entered high school and showed why in the camp. He has a very strong frame and is a very talented scorer. He is also very solid with the ball in his hands and seems to always make his teammates better. His strong academics will make him a coveted prospect this July.

The next group who were selected to the **All Event Team** was highlighted by **Jordan Scott** (6'6" SF Lewis-Palmer HS 2013). He is a great looking prospect who has a number of solid Division I offers on the board. He uses his length to be one of the best defenders in the country and is very versatile on the offensive end of the court. After sitting out this spring with a slight injury, **Scott** is looking great and seems ready to have a huge July. **Justin Smith** (6'6" SF Lewis-Palmer HS 2013) is **Scott's** high school teammate and another great looking prospect. He is long and bouncy and is one of the most versatile players in the state. He shoots the ball very well and scores at the rim as well. A strong July will help **Smith** garner some nice mid to upper mid major offers. **Jevon Taylor** (6'3" SG George Washington HS 2013) is another player with great length who has a lot of upside. He shoots the ball well and attacks the rim very hard. He's certainly one of the most underrated players in the state. **Josh Smith** (6'4" SG Sand Creek HS 2013) is a great looking prospect. He's extremely long and one of the best shooters in the state. He's an explosive scorer with loads of upside who should have a very good July and garner some Division I interest. **Mitch Carter** (6'4" SF Mountain Vista HS 2013) also had a strong camp. He one of the most effective players in the state and plays as hard as anyone you will find. Coming off an outstanding junior year with his high school team, **Carter** should be a coveted prospect this July due to his strong academics.

Also selected to the **All Event Team** was **Leonard Hurst** (6'3" SG Aurora Central HS 2013). He is a versatile athlete who plays hard on both ends of the court and was typically tough in event. He scores well when attacking the rim and is a good rebounder and defender. His high school teammate **Tyler Stevenson** (6'3" SF Aurora Central HS 2013) had a breakout performance in the event as well. He is a good shooter who also rebounds well and plays hard. His high school team will be very good this season and his recruiting stock should improve with his performance in this event. **Lucas Adams** (6'0" PG Frederick HS 2013) was also selected to the **All Event Team**. He is coming off a tremendous spring season and is one of the best pure point guards in the state. He handles the ball very well and always seems to make the extra passes necessary to make his teammates better. Any school looking for a solid point guard will be very happy with **Adams**. **Brendan Mann** (6'3" SG Chatfield HS 2013) was very good in the camp as well. He is one of the best shooters in the region and can really score in bunches. His great length and ability to knock down shots will make him a coveted wing prospect. Last but certainly not least, **Spencer Fair** (6'6" SF Fruita-Monument HS 2013) was selected to the **All Event Team**. He is a versatile athlete who scores well around the rim and can step outside and hit shots from the perimeter as well. He has a great frame that should make him a very intriguing prospect for schools looking for a prospect with tons of upside.

A few other 2013 players had outstanding camps but didn't quite make the **All Event Team**. This group was led by **Carlton Hurst** (6'3" SG Aurora Central HS 2013). He would have certainly made the **All Event Team** and likely would have been one of the **Most Outstanding Players** if he were able to attend the camp both days. Regardless, **Hurst** is a wonderful looking prospect who will have a host of upper mid to high major schools to choose from. He's an explosive athlete who is one of the best natural scorers in the region. He also is a very good passer and rebounder. Similar to **Hurst**, **Brent Wrapp** (6'3" PG Fairview HS 2013) would have likely made the **All Event Team** if he were able to attend both days of the camp. He's one of the best pure point guards in the region with tremendous height for his position. He is an amazing passer and rebounds very well on both ends of the floor. He's also a fierce competitor and should have a great July on the circuit. **Andre Lane** (6'0" SG Evergreen HS 2013) had a great camp as well. He's a smooth wing who plays hard on both ends of the floor and has improved a ton in the last year. **Josiah Dunn** (6'3" SG Lincoln HS 2013) also had a great camp. He has a great build and has improved quite a bit in the last few months. He's a strong finisher in traffic and also defends and rebounds very well. **Cody Steinke** (6'2" SG Elizabeth HS 2013) had a breakout performance in the camp. He's a pure shooter who plays with a ton of energy and is one of the most underrated players in the state.

UNDERCLASSMEN - CLASSES OF 2014 (JUNIORS) AND 2015 (SOPHOMORES)

The classes of 2014 and 2015 in Colorado are extremely strong, especially at the top of each class. Some of those top prospects participated in the camp and showed why the future of Colorado prep basketball is so bright. The three players who were named **Most Outstanding Underclassmen** are very talented and have a chance to be highly recruited in the future. Those players were **Zach Braxton** (6'8" P Highlands Ranch HS 2014), **Dalton Walker** (6'6" SF Windsor HS 2014) and **Brian Carey** (5'8" PG Denver East HS 2015). **Braxton** is a great looking post prospect with loads of upside. He has a great body and looks to still be growing. He has improved his touch around the rim and uses his strength to get good position in the paint. Continued development could see **Braxton** develop into a very nice looking high major prospect. **Walker** is a good-looking prospect with lots of upside as well. He has great height and size for his position. He's very active around the rim on both ends of the court and shoots the ball very well. He looks to still be growing and projects as a solid mid major prospect. **Carey** was simply tremendous in the camp and showed why he's the highest ranked 2015 prospect in the state with an amazing performance. He is a crafty point guard who handles the ball well and can score in bunches as well. He uses his quickness to be a pesky defender. With continued growth, he projects as a high major prospect.

Other underclassmen who played well but didn't quite make the **All Event Team** were **Dylan Clark** (6'0" CG Sand Creek HS 2014), **Chances Matlock** (6'3" SF Falcon HS 2014), **Marcus Asmus** (6'7" CF Standley Lake HS 2014) and **Thaleel Khabir** (6'5" CF Kennedy HS 2015). **Clark** in particular would have most likely made the **All Event Team** if he played both days in the event. **Matlock** was also strongly considered for the **All Event Team** and continues to improve every time he steps on the court.
