

# ROCKY MOUNTAIN FALL SHOWCASE

The spectator attendance was outstanding and over two dozen college coaches and scouts attended. ## SENIOR GAME

### GAME SUMMARY

The **Senior Game** featured a North v. South rivalry for the first time in RMFS history with one team being made of players primarily from the Colorado Springs area and the other team being made of players from the Denver metro area. The game started with the White team from the south taking an early lead behind a huge first quarter from **Josh Scott**. The Black team fought back in the second quarter and trailed by only one at the half. The third quarter was fairly even and the White team eventually pulled away in the fourth quarter and ended up with a 122-107 victory, giving the south team bragging rights.

**Josh Scott** (6'10" P Lewis-Palmer HS – Committed to Colorado) was an easy choice to be named the **Most Outstanding Player** of the game. He was simply dominant in the game and finished with RMFS all time records with 46 points and 20 rebounds. **Wesley Gordon** (6'8" P Sierra HS – Committed to Colorado) and **Jalen Little** (5'10" PG Sierra HS) also had outstanding games.

### TOP PERFORMERS

**Josh Scott** (6'10" P Lewis Palmer HS – Committed to Colorado) was simply amazing in the event and was named the **Most Outstanding Player** in the game. He couldn't be stopped and was a dominant force on both ends of the floor. Scott is the highest ranked Colorado player from Colorado in the last 15 years and proved exactly why he's so highly regarded in the event. He finished the game with an RMFS record 46 points and tied an RMFS record with 20 rebounds. He also added 4 blocks and shot an impressive 14-21 from the field and an even more impressive 18-19 from the free throw line. Scott is a strong, versatile post and will be even more dominant once he adds more weight to his wide frame. He does a great job of mixing strong post moves with crafty moves to the rim from the mid post and short corner and he finishes equally well with both hands. He also has an incredible knack for getting to the free throw line and makes the most of it by knocking down his free throws on a consistent basis. In addition, he rebounds very well and has great timing blocking shots. The bottom line is the Colorado Buffaloes are getting a great looking prospect with tons of upside who will have an amazing career in the Pac Twelve.

**Wesley Gordon** (6'8" P Sierra HS – Committed to Colorado) will be joining Scott in Boulder next year and needless to say, the future post play for the Buffaloes looks like it will be in good hands. Gordon finished the game with a very strong 22 point, 16 rebound, 4 blocked shot performance while shooting 10-15 from the field. He is a long post who rebounds the ball very well and is possibly the best shot blocker from Colorado in the past five years. Continued offensive development will help Gordon be a solid player in college and his upside is tremendous.

**Jalen Little** (5'10" PG Sierra HS) was outstanding in the event and is one of the top unsigned point guards in the region. He handles the ball like it's on a string and has a wonderful understanding of how to control the tempo of a game. Little is very quick and athletic and sees the floor better than any player in the state. He also has a tremendous pull up jump shot and is a strong defender, especially on the ball. He will make a nice mid to low major Division I school very happy in the near future.

**Tanner Samson** (6'4" SG Regis HS – Committed to Elon) recently committed to Elon and showed why he was such a highly coveted recruiting target in the event. Samson chipped in 15 points for his team while making four three pointers in the game. He is an extremely long wing who is one of the best shooters in the country. He is also an outstanding passer and creates tons of turnovers on defense with his length. Samson is a very nice pick up for Elon and should get lots of minutes from the moment he steps on campus.

**Alex Welsh** (6'7" SF Pomona HS – Committed to University of Colorado at Colorado Springs) is a versatile mid-sized player who demonstrated his versatility in the event with a 14 point, 6 rebound, 6 assist, 4 blocked shot effort. Welsh finishes inside very well and shoots the ball equally well from beyond the three point line. He is also a very good passer from his position. He is an excellent pickup for U.C.C.S. and should be able to play big minutes as a freshmen next year.

**Brandon Applehans** (5'10" PG Standley Lake HS – Committed to University of Colorado at Colorado Springs) will be joining Welsh at U.C.C.S. next season and showed why the Mountain Lions wanted to lock him up early. Applehans is a very talented scorer who shoots the ball well from beyond the stripe and mid-range. He also handles the ball well in traffic and does a good job of finding his open teammates when he creates by attacking the rim.

**Shane Jensen (6'7" CF Arapahoe HS – Committed to Fort Lewis)** is a versatile post who is one of the most effective players in the state. He uses crafty moves and tremendous footwork to finish around the rim and is also a good shooter from beyond the stripe. In addition, he's a great rebounder and he should have a great college career at Fort Lewis.

**Austin Haldorson (6'8" CF Highlands Ranch HS – Committed to Wyoming)** is a long and versatile post player who finishes well around the rim and keeps defenders honest with his ability to shoot the ball. He has a ton of upside and should have a great career at Wyoming once he adds some strength and continues to develop.

**Canyon Barry (6'5" SG Cheyenne Mountain HS)** continues to improve every time he steps on the court. He has added some strength in the past few months and that is helping him have more confidence when putting the ball on the deck and attacking the rim. He's a great shooter with great bloodlines (son of NBA Hall of Famer Rick Barry) and has a chance to be a nice mid major prospect with continued development and added strength.

**Chase Duben (6'6" CF Ralston Valley HS)** is a strong left handed post who is one of the best rebounders in the state and finishes well around the rim. Although a bit undersized physically, he plays with tons of heart and energy and has a chance to make an RMAC school very happy in the near future.

**Other standouts include: Kaileb Rodriguez (6'9" CF ThunderRidge HS – Committed to California), Nate Engesser (6'3" CG Colorado Springs Christian HS – Committed to Denver), Luka Mudovic (6'7" SF Pinnacle Charter HS), Cody Heimann (6'4" SG Niwot HS) and Eric Rayer (6'1" PG Coronado HS), amongst others.**

## **JUNIOR GAME**

### **GAME SUMMARY**

The **Junior Game** was the most exciting game of the day. Both teams took their turns leading and the game was close throughout. Both teams were also extremely balanced as 15 of the 19 players who participated in the game scored in double figures. In the end, **Carlton Hurst** and the White team just had a little too much and came away with a 124-122 victory.

**Carlton Hurst (6'2" SG Aurora Central HS)** was an easy choice to be named the **Most Outstanding Player** of the game. He set a short lived RMFS scoring record with 37 points and also did a little bit of everything else and finished with 8 rebounds, 5 assists and 4 steals.

### **TOP PERFORMERS**

**Carlton Hurst (6'2" SG Aurora Central HS)** was unstoppable in the game and was an easy choice for **Most Outstanding Player**. He plays with vigorous energy on both ends of the floor and there quite simply isn't a player in the state who can stop him on their own. He scored a game high and RMFS record 37 points to go along with 8 rebounds, 5 assists and 4 steals. Hurst is an aggressive scorer who plays extremely hard and makes teams better and is a nice upper mid to high major prospect.

**Eric Andres (6'7" SF Thomas Jefferson HS)** is a very nice looking prospect with a ton of upside. He has developed his perimeter skills in the past few months and can play a variety of positions. He scores well around the rim and has developed a solid jump shot to keep defenders honest. Some increased exposure will help him be recruited at the mid major level.

**Mitch Carter (6'4" SF Mountain Vista HS)** is an aggressive mid-sized player with a strong frame who plays very hard. He scores well around the rim and handles and passes the ball well for his position. Some increased perimeter development will help boost his recruiting stock in the next year.

**Brandon Cosby-Lee (6'6" SF Grandview HS)** has been one of the top players in this class for quite some time. He's an athletic and long mid-sized prospect with a lot of upside. He also appears to still be growing and should have a very good junior season playing on one of the best high school teams in the state.

**Alex Terpstra (6'4" SG Denver Christian HS)** was only able to play the first half of the game before he had to leave for a football game (all conference quarterback) but he made a big impression during the time he was able to play. Terpstra is a long wing who shoots the ball extremely well from all over the court. He has deep range and has developed a very nice mid-range game. Some added strength will help him be recruited at the mid to low major level.

**Dezmond James (6'4" SG Ponderosa HS)** made a nice showing in the event as he finished with a team leading 18 points. He recently transferred to Ponderosa from Lewis-Palmer and should immediately help Ponderosa be much improved from where they have been in the past. James has a very quick first step that he uses to attack the rim and finish in traffic.

**Tory Belveal (6'3" SG Cheyenne Mountain HS)** is a versatile guard with a thick frame. He is an outstanding defender who has a knack for taking charges and being in the right place at the right time. He's also a good shooter and finishes well inside.

**Will Keyser (6'6" SF Chaparral HS)** is a bouncy athlete with tons of upside. He has a nice thick frame and is long for his position. Once he understands exactly which position he wants to play, the sky will be the limit for this nice looking prospect.

**Leonard Hurst** (6'1" SG Aurora Central HS) is a high energy left handed wing who is very quick and athletic. He is very aggressive attacking the rim and extremely active on the defensive side of the ball.

**John Cosmann** (6'2" SG Legend HS) had a breakout performance in the event. He shoots the ball very well and made five three pointers in the game. He should have a breakout junior season and can potentially be an all conference selection.

**Zach Rusk** (6'3" SG ThunderRidge HS) continues to impress and looked good in the event. He's a very strong guard who finishes very well through contact and plays hard. He will have a major role this season for one of the best teams in the state.

**Jonathan Parker** (6'3" SG Discovery Canyon HS) is a very talented shooter with good range. He has a thick frame and uses his strength to his advantage on defense and always seems to be in the middle of the action.

## **SOPHOMORE GAME**

### **GAME SUMMARY**

The **Sophomore Game** was very fun to watch and featured some very talented players who project to be upper mid to high major prospects. The first quarter was fairly even but the second quarter saw the White team take a lead they would never lose. A very strong fourth quarter push from the Black team fell a little short and the White team ended up pulling out an 89-85 victory.

**Josh Perkins** (6'2" PG Regis HS) was named the **Most Outstanding Player** with a balanced 21 point, 7 assist, 5 steal effort while leading his team to the victory. **Dominique Collier** (6'1" PG Denver East HS) and **Chase Foster** (6'5" SG Valor Christian HS) also made very strong cases to be named Most Outstanding Player.

### **TOP PERFORMERS**

**Josh Perkins** (6'2" PG Regis HS) was named the **Most Outstanding Player** for the second year in a row. He finished with a solid 21 point, 7 assist, 5 steal effort and lead his team to the victory. Perkins is a strong lead guard who handles the ball well and is extremely difficult for defenders to keep in front of him. He is a great natural scorer who plays with a lot of passion and has a ton of upside. He is a nice looking high major prospect and should continue to improve.

**Dominique Collier** (6'1" PG Denver East HS) is simply a man amongst boys and has the ability to dominate games any time he wants to. Collier is a highly regarded prospect nationally already and is only getting better. He's a smooth point guard who handles the ball very well and can create a shot for himself or his teammates essentially any time he wants. He led a furious comeback from his team in the game and finished with a balanced stat line of 15 points, 6 assists, 6 rebounds, 4 steals and 4 blocks. Collier is an elite prospect who will have virtually every elite high major school in the country clamoring for his services.

**Chase Foster** (6'5" SG Valor Christian HS) is a very nice looking prospect with a ton of upside. He finished with a game high 21 points to go along with 4 rebounds. He shoots the ball very well and uses his tremendous athleticism to elevate and finish in traffic. He's a gifted natural scorer who looks like he's still growing and improving. Some added strength will help him become a high major prospect.

**Tyree Robinson** (6'6" P Denver East HS) is the best post prospect in this class and has improved quite a bit over the past year. He finished the game with 13 points and a game high 12 rebounds. He is very athletic and plays hard around the rim on both ends of the floor. If he continues to grow, he should be a very nice prospect in the next few years.

**Trevon Andres** (6'5" SF Thomas Jefferson HS) is a very nice looking prospect who is versatile and has a ton of upside. He's very long for his position and looks to be still growing. He finishes well inside and attacks the rim well.

**Sherron Wilson** (6'5" SG Sierra HS) is a very nice looking prospect who is still growing and should add a few inches to his frame. He shoots the ball well and uses his length to create turnovers on defense. He is a very good looking prospect and continued development and growth will help him become a very nice high major prospect.

**Ben Beauchamp** (6'3" PG Monarch HS) is yet another 2014 prospect who has a ton of upside and is still growing. He has extremely good court vision and a great frame for his position. An improved jump shot will help him develop into a nice mid major prospect.

**J.J. Griffin** (6'2" CG Denver East HS) is a very versatile lead guard who can play either guard position. He has a quick first step and attacks the rim very hard. He also has a thick frame and all the makings of a high major guard prospect.

**Dylan Clark** (6'0" SG Sand Creek HS) is a lights out shooting lefty who has improved his ability to attack the rim and handle the ball. He should be one of the top scoring sophomores in the state this season.

**LeDarian King** (6'0" PG Eaglecrest HS) is a quick and shifty point guard who plays hard on defense and can score in a variety of ways on offense. He plays hard and has good natural leadership abilities.

# FRESHMEN GAME

## GAME SUMMARY

The **Freshman Game** was unfortunately a blowout from the get go. The Black team jumped out early and took a lead in the first quarter. The White team fought back a little bit in the second quarter but the Black team ended up with a lopsided 94-65 victory.

**Chris Moody (6'4" CF Chaparral HS)** was named the **Most Outstanding Player** on the game behind a strong 23 point, 18 rebound, 4 block effort. Super eighth grader **Deron Davis (6'7" P Denver East HS)** made a strong case as well with a 20 point, 8 rebound, 8 block performance.

## TOP PERFORMERS

**Chris Moody (6'5" CF Chaparral HS)** was tremendous in the event and was named **Most Outstanding Player** behind a 23 point, 18 rebound, 4 blocked shot effort. He finishes well inside and does a great job rebounding on both ends of the floor. He also is very skilled for his position and has the ability to hit shots behind the arch and put the ball on the deck and attack the rim. Moody is a great looking prospect with tons of upside who projects as a big small forward in college.

**Deron Davis (6'7" P Denver East HS 2016)** is an absolute beast and has as much upside as any player in the state, regardless of class. Playing up in the Freshmen Game as an 8<sup>th</sup> grader, he dominated the paint and finished with an impressive 20 points, 8 rebounds and an RMFS record 8 blocked shots while shooting an efficient 9-12 from the floor. Davis is extremely physically imposing and has an inside presence that commands attention. He finishes well inside with strong moves and has tremendous timing when blocking shots. Although it's extremely early in his career, he projects as an elite high major prospect.

**Bryan Staerkel (6'1" SG Regis HS)** is one of the best shooters in the state, regardless of class. He has a quick release and can score at all three levels; at the rim, mid-range and from behind the arch. He also runs the floor well and scores in transition and is a very good defender, both on and off the ball.

**Vaughn Samson (6'2" SG Regis HS)** is a very long wing prospect with loads of upside. He shoots the ball well and uses tremendous footwork to beat defenders off the dribble and attack the rim. He should continue to grow and projects as a very nice prospect who should receive some upper mid to high major interest over the next few years.

**DeShawn Wilson (6'1" SF Sierra HS 2017)** is a great looking prospect. He's only in the seventh grade and played two years up in the event and was as good as any player on the floor. He already possesses a strong frame and plays very hard on both ends of the floor. The sky is the limit for this 2017 prospect who has an extremely bright future ahead of him on the basketball court.

**Michael Sparks (5'8" PG Lincoln HS)** is a lightning quick point guard who loves to push the ball on the break. He plays hard and with a lot of passion. If he grows a little bit, he could be a nice prospect in the years to come.

**Tyler Garcia (6'0" SG Rock Canyon HS)** is a very good shooter and has a nice frame for his position. He is a versatile lead guard who can play a variety of positions and a gifted natural scorer.

**Mitch Lombard (6'1" SG Rock Canyon HS)** is a long wing who does a lot of things right on the court. He shoots the ball well and finishes well at the rim and is also a solid defender.
