

TOP OF THE ROCKIES

Welcome to the 2019 Top of the Rockies. Enclosed you will find all the information you will need to know about the premier tournament in the Rocky Mountain Region.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- All teams are guaranteed four games using pool play format with single elimination tournament brackets and consolation games. Pools are weighted to provide appropriate competition level.

GAME PLAY

All normal high school rules apply except for the following:

- All games will be played using 16 minute, stop clock halves. The clock will run the last 8:00 minutes of the second half if a team is ahead by 20 or more points. The game will be called for the Mercy Rule with 3:00 left if one team is ahead by 20 or more points.
- Teams will receive three timeouts per game. Players will be allowed 6 personal fouls per game before being disqualified. Bonus will be shot on the 10th Team Foul in each half. There will be no double bonus.
- Overtimes will be 2 minutes stop clock and teams will receive one additional 30-second time out. Any remaining timeouts from regulation will not carry over into the overtime periods.
- **Each team MUST provide a volunteer to run either the clock or keep the book for every game. If a scorekeeper is not provided, the team will forfeit the game.**
- Warm up time will vary based on how much time is left until the scheduled start time of the game. All games will start on time and not start early in order to allow college coaches, and spectators to not miss any action.
- In case of ties in pool play, seeding will be determined by; A) Head to head competition, B) Point differential with a maximum of 15 points for a win or loss, C) Total points scored, D) Coin flip.

MISCELLANEOUS

- All games will be played at the Gold Crown Fieldhouse in Lakewood, Colorado. Detailed results, pool standings and playoff brackets will be kept. Please check in after you last pool game to make sure you know when and where your first playoff game will be. This information will all be available online as well.
- If you haven't paid your **entry fees**, you need to do so immediately. Failure to pay your entry fees will result in a forfeit loss for your team until the entry fees have been paid. You can pay entry fees online at www.ColoradoChaos.com or pay them at team check in on Friday night.
- An **All Tournament Team** for each division will be chosen at the end of the tournament. Each team will get to nominate three players from **your own team**. Teams playing in the Championship Game may nominate four players. Not all players nominated will make the team. The **nomination form** is enclosed and **MUST** be turned in to a member of the tournament staff after your last game.
- **Sportsmanship Rule:** If a coach, player or parent or fan is ejected from a game for any reason, they will be suspended for the following game, no questions asked. This rule applies to fans as well as team personnel. All decisions of the Tournament Director and tournament staff are final and cannot be appealed in any way.
- A spectator **entry fee** of \$10 for adults and \$7 for children and seniors (Under 10 / Over 65) will be charged daily. This fee will get you into the games all day. Tournament passes will also be sold for \$25.
